UNIFORM POLICY



At Kimberley Park State School, it is the expectation that all students who choose to attend our school will wear the correct uniform at all times. Students and parents agree to adhere to the uniform policy when they complete the enrolment procedure.

This policy has been established in joint consultation with the School Council, P&C, leadership team and staff of Kimberley Park State School.

Wearing the uniform encourages our students to have pride in themselves and our school. It also provides each child with a strong sense of belonging. The school uniform has been designed to be:

- Practical for the needs of children during their active days at school
- Long-wearing
- Cost-effective
- Sun-safe, with the current uniform meeting the suggested guidelines for Sun Safe school uniforms.

SUMMER UNIFORM

- Navy shorts* or tartan culottes*
- School polo shirt with embroidered school logo*
- Navy wide brimmed* or legionnaire hat
- Navy socks*
- Black flexible-soled closed-in shoes.

All items marked with an asterisk are available for purchase from School Locker.*

WINTER UNIFORM

Comprises of the summer uniform with the addition of:

- Navy v-neck fleecy pullover with embroidered school logo* or plain navy pullover
- Navy microfibre zipped jacket with embroidered school logo* or plain navy jacket
- Navy trackpants
- Navy tights worn under shorts or culottes

PLEASE NOTE: No hoodies or jumpers with visible logos other than the school logo are to be worn.

SCHOOL POLO YEAR LEVEL COLOURS

Prep: navy polo

Years 1-4: maroon polo

Year 5: Senior navy polo and maroon polo

Year 6: Senior navy polo and Year 6 Commemorative shirt

SPECIALITY POLOS

Senior commemorative polo*, STEM polo* and Performing Arts polo* may be worn in place of school polo.

Sports-house coloured polo* may be worn on Fridays and for key sporting events.

HATS

Kimberley Park State School enforces a strict *NO HAT NO PLAY* policy. All children are required to wear a hat that protects the face, neck and ears whenever they are involved in outdoor activities. In line with this policy, the following applies:

- Caps are not suitable as they do not give sufficient sun protection
- The reversible school wide-brimmed hat is the preferred option for all students.
- If a student does not have a suitable hat, they will be required to sit in the tuckshop area during break times.

JEWELLERY

Jewellery is not a part of the school uniform. In the interests of the personal safety of each child, it is recommended that jewellery be confined to a watch and small plain sleepers or stud earrings for those with pierced ears. Religious or cultural pendants are to be worn inside the shirt when at school.

HAIR

Hair accessories should be in the school colours of navy or maroon.

OUT-OF-UNIFORM EVENTS

Kimberley Park State School has a number of free-dress or costume days during the year when students are permitted to wear casual clothes or a costume. Clothing on these days still needs to be sun-safe and school appropriate.

UNIFORM INFRINGEMENT

When a child presents out of school uniform, a quick rule and expectation reminder is provided. During winter, a school jumper will be offered to students who attend in a hoodie or jumper/jacket with a visible logo
